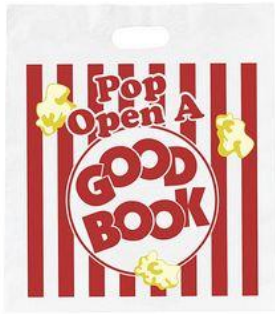


Library News

Tuesday: Kinder/Year 1 and Years 2/3

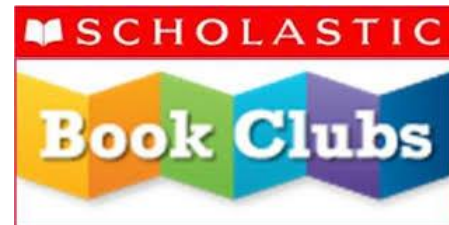
Wednesday: Year 4 and Years 5/6
